

# EUROPEAN ARTISTIC SWIMMING JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

(UPDATED 14.05.2022)

In addition to the LEN General Event Rules the following

## REGULATIONS

shall apply:

### J - AS 1 ORGANISATION

- J - AS-1.1 The Championships shall be held every year.
- J - AS-1.2 The organising Federation and the place where the Championships shall be held shall be decided by the LEN Bureau and circulated by the LEN Office.
- J - AS 1.3 The Commission (Bureau Liaison, TASC Chairman, TASC Vice-Chairman and TASC Hon. Secretary) shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation and the correct conduct of the competitions according to LEN Rules and regulations.
- The Commission shall decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

### J - AS 2 EVENTS & PARTICIPATION

- J - AS 2.1 Age Group: Juniors, 15 to 18 years
- J - AS 2.2 Events are Solo Female and Solo Male, Duet, Mixed Duet, Team, Free Combination and Highlight Routine
- J - AS 2.3 Federations may submit entries for:
- one (1) Solo Technical Female with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Solo Free Female with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Solo Technical Male with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Solo Free Male with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Duet Technical with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Duet Free with maximum one (1) reserve
  - one (1) Mixed Duet Technical with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum 1 (one) reserve male or female
  - one (1) Mixed Duet Free with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum 1 (one) reserve male or female
  - one Team Technical with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum four (4) reserves
  - one Team Free with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum four (4) reserves
  - one Free Routine Combination with six (6) to ten (10) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
  - one Highlight Routine with eight (8) to ten (10) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
- J - AS 2.4 The total number athletes entered may not exceed fifteen (15) in case of one (1) Mixed Duet and/or one (1) Solo male,  
In case there is no Solo Male and no Mixed Duet the maximum number of athletes may not exceed twelve (12).

Note: All LEN Artistic Swimming competitions are open to both genders

### J - AS 3 FORMAT

- J - AS 3.1 Each event is calculated separately: Solo Technical Female 100%, Solo Technical Male 100%, Duet Technical 100%, Mixed Duet Technical 100%, Team Technical 100%, Solo Free Female 100%, Solo Free Male 100%, Duet Free 100%, Mixed Duet Free 100%, Team Free 100%, Free Combination, 100%, Highlight Routine 100%
- J - AS 3.2 If there are more than twelve (12) entries in Solo Free or Duet Free, Preliminaries shall be held.
- J - AS 3.3 Free Solos and Free Duets ranked 1st to 12th after Solo Free Preliminary and Duet Free Preliminary shall qualify for Solo Free Final and Duet Free Final.
- J - AS 3.4 The composition of Solos (for preliminaries only), Duets, Teams, Free Combination and Highlight Routine shall be declared no later than two hours before the commencement of the session in which the event shall take place.
- J - AS 3.5 Withdrawals from any Finals shall be announced no later than one (1) hour after the end of the

Preliminaries concerned, otherwise they shall be fined (See Rule E 17.6.)

**J - AS 4                    ENTRIES**

J - AS 4.1                  Preliminary Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the LEN Office, no later than the date circulated by the LEN Office.

J - AS 4.2                  A Federation having made a Preliminary Entry may withdraw up to the date circulated by the LEN Office.

J - AS 4.3                  Named Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the LEN Office, no later than ten (10) days before the first day of the competition, if not announced otherwise.

J - AS 4.4                  Competitors who cannot prove identity, age and citizenship shall not be permitted to take part in the competitions.

**J - AS 5                    ACCREDITATION**

J - AS 5.1                  Federations entering the Championships shall receive accreditation for:

- a) the President of the Federation;
- b) the Head of the Delegation;
- c) the entered competitors;
- d) one medical person;
- e) A minimum of 4 team staff members, but the number of team staff may not exceed the number of competitors plus one.

J - SY 5.2                  Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: Team Leaders, Chaperones, Coaches, Physiotherapists, Interpreters, etc. but not officials such as judges, referees, etc.

**J - AS 6                    AWARDS**

J - AS 6.1                  Medals shall be awarded for each event to the competitors placed first, second and third in each event.

J - AS 6.2                  Diplomas shall be awarded to the competitors placed first to eight.

**J - AS 7                    OFFICIALS**

J - AS 7.1                  In addition to the Commission the LEN TASC shall nominate one (1) Referee, one (1) Assistant Referee and three (3) Evaluators.

J - AS 7.2                  Federations must nominate one or two judges qualified on the current FINA list but only one judge from category G.  
The selected judges must have passed the current FINA school. They are obliged to take part in all meetings and must be present to all competition sessions.  
Nominations shall be submitted to the LEN office no later than the date announced by the LEN Office.  
Officials approved by LEN are on the costs of the nominating Federation.

J - AS 7.3                  The Organising Federation shall supply all other officials. The Announcer, the Music center Manager and the Chief recorder are to be approved by LEN.

J - AS 7.4                  For each session the LEN TASC Commission shall nominate the judges' panels and other officials.

J - AS 7.5                  Acting judges shall be evaluated.
