EURO 5 ARTISTIC SWIMMING

EURO 5.1 Events and Participation

EURO 5.1.1 Events are:

- Solo Technical Female;
- Solo Free Female
- Solo Technical Male
- Solo Free Male
- Duet Technical
- Duet Free
- Mixed Duet Technical
- Mixed Duet Free
- Team Technical
- Team Free
- Free Combination
- Highlight Routine

EURO 5.1.2 Federations may submit entries for:

- one (1) Solo Technical Female with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Solo Free Female with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Solo Technical Male with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Solo Free Male with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Duet Technical with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Duet Free with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Mixed Duet Technical with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum 1 reserve male or female
- one (1) Mixed Duet Free with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum 1 reserve male or female
- one Team Technical with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum four (4) reserves
- one Team Free with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum four (4) reserves
- one Free Combination with six (6) to ten (10) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
- one Highlight Routine with eight (8) to ten (10) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves

The total number of athletes entered may not exceed fifteen (15) in case of one (1) Mixed Duet and/or one (1) Solo Male.

In case there is no Solo Male and/or no Mixed Duet entered the maximum number of athletes may not exceed twelve (12).

EURO 5.2 Standards

EURO 5.2.1 All LEN Federations wishing to participate to the EC will be allowed to compete with their athletes without any required standard.

EURO 5.3 Qualification System

EURO 5.3.1 Solo Free Female, Duet Free and Team Free will be held with Preliminaries and Finals. If there are more than twelve (12) entries in Technical Routines, Free Combination, Highlight Routine, Solo Free Male and Mixed Duet Free, Preliminaries may be held.

EURO 5.3.2 The twelve (12) best results shall qualify for the Final.

EURO 5.3.3 The Finals shall start with zero points ("Clean Finals").

EURO 5.3.4 Withdrawals from any Finals shall be announced no later than one (1) hour after the end of the Preliminaries concerned, otherwise they shall be fined (See Rule E 17.6.)

EURO 5.4 Composition of Routines

The composition of Solos, Duets, Mixed Duets, Teams, Free Combinations and Highlight Routines shall be declared no later than two hours before the commencement of the session in which the event shall take place.

EURO 5.5 Officials

EURO 5.5.1 LEN TASC shall nominate one (1) Referee, the judges' panels, the other officials and three (3) Evaluators.

EURO 5.5.2 Federations may nominate one or two judges qualified on the current FINA and/or LEN List(s) but only one judge from Category G ("General").

The selected judges must have passed the current FINA School and the latest online test. They are obliged to take part in all meetings and must be present to all competition sessions.

Nominations shall be submitted to the LEN Office no later than the date announced by the LEN Office. Officials approved by LEN are on the costs of the nominating Federation.

EURO 5.5.3 The Organising Federation shall supply all other officials. The Announcer, the Music center Manager and the Chief recorder are to be approved by LEN.

EURO 5.5.4 Acting judges shall be evaluated.

EURO 5.6 Team Staff Accreditation

Each Federation entering one or more Artistic Swimming event(s) shall receive maximum seven (7) team staff accreditations (see EURO 2.2.1).

However the number of team staff members shall not exceed the number of competitors plus one.

EURO 5.7 Championships Trophy Artistic Swimming

EURO 5.7.1 The Trophy shall be awarded to the Federation obtaining the highest number of points according to the following system:

- a) In Solo events; 1st place: 72 points and until 13th place always two points less; 13th place: 48 points and until the last place always one point less;
- b) In Duet events; 1st place: 120 points and until 13th place always three points less; 13th place: 84 points and until the last place always two points less;
- c) In Team, Free routine Combination and Highlight Routine events; 1st place: 192 points and until 13th place always four points less; 13th place: 144 points and until the last place always three points less.

EURO 5.7.2 In case of a tie with the highest points the Trophy shall be awarded to the Federation having obtained most points in the Team Free Event. If there is still a tie, the higher ranking in the Team Technical event shall determine the place, and if there is still a tie, the higher ranking in Free combination, then in Duet Free, then in Duet Technical.
