

LEN EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

In addition to the LEN General Event Rules the following

REGULATIONS

shall apply:

S - AS 1 ORGANISATION

S - AS-1.1 The Championships shall be held every second year, in the alternate years to the LEN European Championships.

S - AS-1.2 All the rules of the European Artistic Swimming Championships shall apply unless exceptions are specified.

S - AS The organising Federation and the place where the Championships shall be held, shall be decided by the LEN Bureau and the information circulated by the LEN Office.

S - AS 1.3 The LEN TASC shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation and the correct conduct of the competition according to LEN Rules and Regulations.

The Commission shall decide on all matters arising on site at the competitions which require an immediate decision.

S - AS 2 EVENTS & PARTICIPATION

S - AS 2.1 Events are Duet, Mixed Duet, Team, Free Combination and Acrobatic Routine.

S - AS 2.2 Federations may submit entries for:

- one (1) Duet Technical with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Duet Free with maximum one (1) reserve
- one (1) Mixed Duet Technical with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum one (1) male reserve and one (1) female reserve
- one (1) Mixed Duet Free with one (1) male athlete and one (1) female athlete with maximum one (1) male reserve and one (1) female reserve
- one Team Technical with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
- one Team Free with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
- one Free Combination with four (4) to ten (10) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves
- one Acrobatic Routine with four (4) to eight (8) athletes with maximum two (2) reserves

S - AS 2.3 The total number of athletes entered may not exceed fourteen (14).

Note: All events are open to male and female athletes, unless specified in the title of the event.

S - AS 3 ACCREDITATION

S - AS 3.1 Federations entering the Championships shall receive accreditation for:

- a) the President of the Federation;
- b) the Head of the Delegation;
- c) the entered competitors;
- d) one medical person;
- e) a maximum of seven (7) team staff members, but the number of team staff may not exceed the number of competitors plus one.

S - AS 3.2 Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: team leaders, chaperones, coaches, physiotherapists, interpreters, etc. but not officials such as judges, referees, etc.
