

EUROPEAN HIGH DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS
In addition to the LEN General Event Rules, the following
REGULATIONS
shall apply:

EHDC 1 ORGANISATION

EHDC 1.1 The European High Diving Championships shall be held bi-annually.

EHDC 1.2 The organising Federation and the location of the Championships will be decided by the LEN Bureau and circulated by the LEN Office.

EHDC 1.3 One (1) Delegate of the LEN Bureau to be appointed by the Bureau and the members of the LEN Technical High Diving Committee (THDC) shall be responsible for and supervise the organisation of the event according to LEN Rules and Regulations. The Bureau Delegate and the members of the THDC will be responsible for all matters relating to the delivery of a successful High Diving Event for LEN.

EHDC 2 EVENTS

EHDC 2.1 Events are:
Men: [20m](#) platform
Women: 20m platform

EHDC 2.2 The order of events will be decided by the LEN THDC, subject to the approval of the LEN Executive, and circulated by the LEN Office.

EHDC 2.3 The two events shall be [organised in a program](#) of two (2) days, if not announced otherwise.

Day 1: Round 1 and 2 for women and men

Day 2: Round 3 and 4 for women and men

EHDC 3 PARTICIPATION

EHDC 3.1 In both events three (3) competitors per Federation may be entered.

EHDC 3.2 All entered high divers [not previously known](#) will be required to submit video evidence for qualification purposes to the LEN THDC.

EHDC 4 FORMAT

EHDC 4.1 [The events shall be held as direct finals.](#)

The order of diving shall be determined by a random draw. The random draw will take place at the Technical [Meeting following the final training session](#). When available an electronic draw shall be used.

The last round shall be performed in the reverse order of the ranking at the end of the previous round.

EHDC 4.2 The competition for women on the 20m platform shall comprise four (4) dives. One (1) required dive with a maximum Degree of Difficulty (DD) of 2.6 and one (1) intermediate dive with a maximum Degree of Difficulty (DD) of 3.4. These two dives must be selected from two different take-off positions and two (2) dives without limit of DD from two (2) different groups. A dive of the same number shall be regarded as the same dive.

If the DD of a required dive is less than 2.6 or intermediate dive is less than the 3.4 the calculated DD following appendixes HD [11.1](#) and HD [11.2 \(World Aquatics\)](#) will be used. If a diver performs a dive above 2.6 or 3.4 he will only receive 2.6 or 3.4.

A competitor may provide on the statement of dives two (2) reserve dives which may be substituted five (5) minutes before the commencement of the final round of dives subject to the dive being compliant with the competition rules.

EHDC 4.3 The competition for men on the 20m platform shall comprise four (4) dives.

One (1) required dives with a maximum Degree of Difficulty (DD) of 2.6 and one (1) intermediate dive with a maximum DD of 3.4 from two (2) different take-off positions and two (2) dives without limit of DD from two (2) different groups. A dive of the same number shall be regarded as the same dive.

If the DD of a required dive is less than 2.6 or intermediate dive is less than the 3.4 the calculated DD following appendixes HD 11.1 and HD 11.2 (World Aquatics) will be used. If a diver performs a dive above 2.6 or 3.4 he will only receive 2.6 or 3.4.

A competitor may provide on the statement of dives two (2) reserve dives which may be substituted five (5) minutes before the commencement of the final round of dives subject to the dive being compliant with the competition rules.

EHDC 4.4 In case of a tie after round 3 the dive order shall be determined by a draw between the affected divers.

EHDC 4.5 In case of a tie after the last round all tied high divers will be ranked at the same place.

EHDC 5 ENTRIES

EHDC 5.1 LEN Office will circulate with the announcement of the European High Diving Championships a list with competitors who fulfil the safety requirements.

Competitors not on that list must send together with the named entries a link to a video with dives which demonstrate that the competitor has safe control of his dive program. The LEN THDC may reject the nomination of a competitor if a safe control is not shown.

EHDC 5.2 Preliminary Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with a copy to the LEN Office, no later than the date circulated by the LEN Office.

EHDC 5.3 A Federation having made a Preliminary Entry may withdraw up to the date circulated by the LEN Office.

EHDC 5.4 Named Entries shall be submitted to the organising Federation, with copy to the LEN Office, up to the date circulated by the LEN Office.

EHDC 5.5 Competitors who cannot prove identity, age and citizenship shall not be permitted to take part in the competition.

EHDC 6 ACCREDITATION

EHDC 6.1 Federations entering the High Diving Championships will receive accreditation for:

- a) the President of the Federation.
- b) the Head of Delegation.
- c) the entered competitors.
- d) one medical person.
- e) team staff members:
 - 2 for up to 2 competitors.
 - 3 for up to 4 competitors.
 - 4 for up to 6 competitors.

EHDC 6.2 Team staff members include everybody servicing the team: Team Leaders, Coaches, Physiotherapists, etc. (not officials such as judges, referees, etc.).

EHDC 7 AWARDS

EHDC 7.1 Medals will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event.

EHDC 7.2 Diplomas will be awarded to the competitors placed 1st to 8th of each event.

EHDC 8 OFFICIALS

EHDC 8.1 The LEN THDC shall appoint the Referee and the Judges.

EHDC 8.2 Assigned judges are not allowed to act as coaches throughout the Championships. Judges who do not respect this Regulation shall be excluded from the Championships.

EHDC 8.3 Assigned judges may be evaluated.
